

ELEVATING RESIDENT CARE WITH DONOR SUPPORT

Staffing shortages of professional caregivers has been a challenge, especially in communities outside of metro areas. Now, through an innovative partnership with Workforce Hope and funding from the New Americans Long-Term Care Workforce grant from the Minnesota Department of Human Services, we're addressing this challenge by welcoming new Americans into the senior care workforce.

Two new American citizens joined Ecumen as Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) trainees. They received CNA training, mentorship, and vital community resources. One has already passed the certification exam, and we're helping the second prepare for success. We're not just hiring—we're helping them thrive. Each receives essentials and a local cultural and community center membership. We also provide cultural sensitivity training to create a welcoming environment for all.
